\$167,410  
FOR CHILDREN AT ROYAL UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL**

Jarret Stoll, #28 LA Kings, and his NHL friends, have done it again. They raised \$167,410 (after expenses) for children and their families at Royal University Hospital, bringing their total fundraising effort to more than half a million in just four years!

In recognition of Jarret's significant contribution to the RUH Foundation, a special ceremony took place at RUH in honor of Jarret Stoll, who hails from Melville, SK. The Pediatric waiting area was renamed the Jarret Stoll Comfort Zone in honor of the Jarret Stoll Patient Comfort Fund Endowment for Children at Royal University Hospital. Jarret also announced the items purchased with funds generated from his endowment: a Sleep Chair for pediatrics; a vital signs monitors for Pediatric Emergency; children's furniture for the Mental Health & Addictions Waiting Room and special equipment for OR Pediatric beds.

The 4<sup>th</sup> annual sold out teed off Thursday afternoon with a community autograph session at Boston Pizza on 51<sup>st</sup>, the Presenting Sponsor of the Jarret Stoll Celebrity Golf Classic. It then moved to beily's for the Celebrity Auction, where over \$82,000 was raised by auctioning the opportunity to golf with an NHL player, plus great NHL memorabilia. Today was a great day on the links at the Moon Lake Golf & Country Club where Jarret announced he will be back next year – June 24 & 25, 2010!
